HOW TO LEGALISE A DOCUMENT ?

Step One: All documents must be taken to a Notary Public or Solicitor first, to be signed (<u>except those issued by the Registry</u> <u>Office</u>) documents from the Isle of Man, British Virgin island, Jersey and Guernsey also need to goes direct into the F.C.O., <u>address below</u>.

Step Two: to the Legalisation Department at the Foreign Office:

Last Step: At the Chilean Consulate, the cost of a legalisation is £9 per document. *For payments please deposit the referred amount at any HSBC Bank branch, to the Chilean Consulate bank account (details attached)* Please send documentation by post together with the document already legalised by the Foreign Office, the deposit (receipt stamped original only) a covering letter specifying the amount of documents and a telephone number with contact name and a **S.A.E.** to send it back to the following address:
